Please turn off cell phones. We would appreciate if you would not text during performances. It is distracting to those around you and it is not respectful to the performers.



Piano & strings competitors: Please number the first measure of each line in your music to hand in to the adjudicator secretary.

SEMF strongly encourages competitors to hand in their music at least 15 minutes before their time of performance.

It is never appropriate to discuss grievances with the adjudicator. Please contact a Festival committee member in writing.

## **SEMF Grading System**

SEMF follows the grading system below for all competitive entries:

Grade	Mark	Performance Standard
A +	90 to 100	signifies superior performance
Α	85 to 89	signifies distinction
A -	80 to 84	signifies definite merit
В	75 to 79	signifies adequate
С	70 to 74	signifies fair standard

The decision of the adjudicator regarding ranking of participants must be accepted as final. At no time must anyone approach the adjudicator to discuss any matter.

\*\*\*NEW this year: AMAF has introduced a 6th participation level eligible for Provincial recommendations in the new online syllabus:

- Primary (P) vocalists 12 years & under and instrumentalists grades/levels 1-2
- Elementary (E) (previously known as Preliminary) vocalists 14 years & under and instrumentalists grades/levels 3-4
- Junior (J) vocalists 16 years & under and instrumentalists grades/levels 5-6
- Intermediate (I) vocalists 18 years & under and instrumentalists grades/levels 7-8
- Advanced (A) vocalists grades C (new) & B and instrumentalists grades/levels 9-10
- Senior (S) vocalists grade A & Honours and instrumentalists diploma/honours levels

Provincial eligible classes begin with the letter "P".

#### **Adjudicator: Darryl Friesen**

Darryl Friesen has given acclaimed performances as a soloist and collaborative artist across Canada, the United States, Europe, China, and Brazil. He has performed as soloist with the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra, and as a collaborator and recitalist with many distinguished artists, including Elliot Madore, Andrew Wan, Allen Harrington, Catherine Daniel, Millicent Scarlett, Valdine

Anderson, the Adaskin String Trio, and the Martha Graham Dance Company. Darryl's debut album, Curlicue: The Solo Piano Works of Karen Sunabacka, was released by Ravello Records in September 2022.

Dr. Friesen began his piano studies with Darrel Loewen at the Manitoba Conservatory of Music & Arts. After further studies with renowned pedagogue, Lee Kum-Sing, at the Vancouver Academy of Music, Dr. Friesen went on to receive BM and MM degrees in Piano Performance from the University of Manitoba as a student of well-known Canadian pianist, Dr. David Moroz, and subsequently completed his DMA at the University of Illinois, studying under Fulbright scholar, Dr. William Heiles, and esteemed collaborative pianist and coach, Prof. Dennis Helmrich. His doctoral studies were made possible through generous grants from the Canada Council of the Arts in 2005 and 2006, including the coveted Sylva Gelber Foundation Award, given annually to the most talented Canadian classical artist under the age of 30.

Dr. Friesen is in great demand as a soloist, collaborative artist, teacher, and clinician. He and his wife live with their four children in Winnipeg, Manitoba, where he teaches full time at the University of Manitoba's Desautels Faculty of Music.


