Please turn off cell phones. We would appreciate if you would not text during performances. It is distracting to those around you and it is not respectful to the performers.



Photocopies handed in to adjudicator secretaries will lead to disqualification for scholarships. Exceptions to this are listed in the SEMF 2023-2024 Addendum.

Piano & strings competitors: Please number the first measure of each line in your music to hand in to the adjudicator secretary.

SEMF strongly encourages competitors to hand in their music at least 15 minutes before their time of performance.

It is never appropriate to discuss grievances with the adjudicator. Please contact a Festival committee member in writing.

SEMF Grading System

SEMF follows the grading system below for all competitive entries:

Grade	Mark	Performance Standard
A +	90 to 100	signifies superior performance
Α	85 to 89	signifies distinction
A -	80 to 84	signifies definite merit
В	75 to 79	signifies adequate
С	70 to 74	signifies fair standard

The decision of the adjudicator regarding ranking of participants must be accepted as final. At no time must anyone approach the adjudicator to discuss any matter.

***NEW this year: AMAF has introduced a 6th participation level eligible for Provincial recommendations in the new online syllabus:

- Primary (P) vocalists 12 years & under and instrumentalists grades/levels 1-2
- Elementary (E) (previously known as Preliminary) vocalists 14 years & under and instrumentalists grades/levels 3-4
- Junior (J) vocalists 16 years & under and instrumentalists grades/levels 5-6
- Intermediate (I) vocalists 18 years & under and instrumentalists grades/levels 7-8
- Advanced (A) vocalists grades C (new) & B and instrumentalists grades/levels 9-10
- Senior (S) vocalists grade A & Honours and instrumentalists diploma/honours levels

Provincial eligible classes begin with the letter "P".




Adjudicator: Laurel Howard

A longtime member of Winnipeg's Suzuki community, she has also taught for the Winnipeg Youth Orchestras, Sistema Winnipeg, the Winnipeg and Seven Oaks School Divisions, and at many workshops and camps. She has adjudicated widely across western Canada.

Laurel instructs the String Techniques class for the University of Manitoba's Desautels Faculty of Music and is String Coordinator for the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra's Adventures in Music program.
